

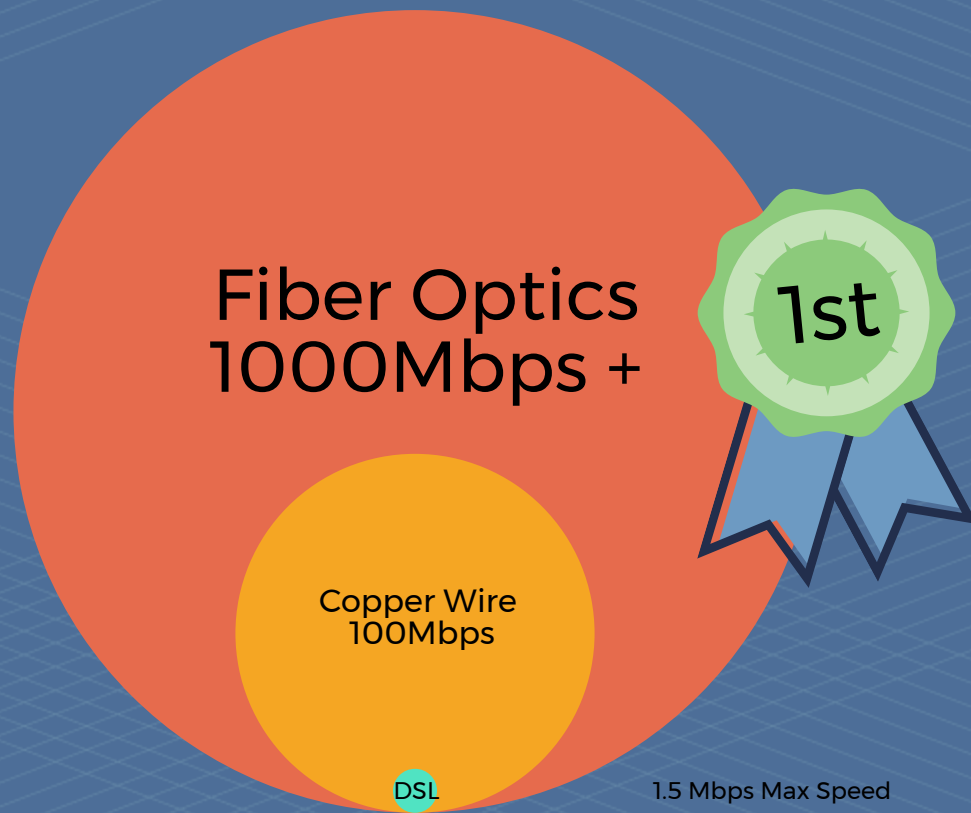
HOW DOES FIBER COMPARE?

Fiber is future-proof.

While legacy copper networks are struggling to keep up with growing bandwidth needs, fiber optic networks are already capable of carrying more bandwidth than we currently know how to utilize. Fiber optic networks are not just the network for today, but for the future needs of our community.

Fiber goes the distance.

Fiber loses only 3% signal strength going over 100 meters (approximately 320 feet) in distance. By contrast, copper loses 94% over the same distance.
